THE ART GALLERY OF BALLARAT

The Art Gallery of Ballarat is the oldest, largest and most engaging regional art gallery in Australia. Its permanent collection provides insights into Australia's art, culture and society through paintings, prints and drawings and sculpture from early colonial through to contemporary and Indigenous works. It also includes work of regional artists and works depicting the growth of Ballarat.

The Gallery's temporary exhibitions provide opportunities to connect artworks to a range of different study areas, so there is always something new for you and your students to see.

WHAT DO WE OFFER?

The Art Gallery of Ballarat offers a range of programs designed for Kindergarten, Primary, Secondary and Tertiary students as well as educators and community or youth groups.

Programs focus on the collection or on temporary exhibitions. The AGB Education team can design programs to connect to specific themes which students are exploring as part of an inquiry unit.

Tours and activities are generally designed to be completed in forty-five minutes to one hour.
